The Men's IXV pre-season is well under way. We are delighted that Henry Bryce is staying on for his second season as Head coach, ably assisted by Declan Quinn as forwards coach and Mal Malone as team Manager. Conor Caldwell is remaining as Captain. Ciaran Verdon has come on stream as senior men's co-ordinator.

This year Balbriggan will be playing in Leinster League Division 2A for the first time. This is the highest level the club has ever played at in the Leinster League and so is a very exciting time indeed for the club. The first match of their league campaign is on Sunday 22nd September when the men play North Kildare. Our first home match of the League campaign is the following Sunday against Newbridge who are coached this season by former Ireland and Munster utility back, Johne Murphy.



The season starts a month before the league campaign gets underway. The annual Beachy Cup Festival is being played on Saturday 24th August in Ashbourne. The following weekend, Balbriggan make their first appearance in very many years the North East McGowan Cup (J1). This competition is being played over two weekends. The first weekend is a blitz format when all four teams in the competition play each other in Dundalk RFC to determine which two teams will play in the McGowan Cup Final and which two play in the McGowan Plate. The Cup and Plate finals are to be played the following weekend, Saturday 7th September in Boyne. The Plate will kick off at 2pm and is followed by the Cup final to be played at 3.30pm.
